What do we know about dementia and driving?

- ❖ Dementia eventually has an effect on capacity to drive
- ❖ Searching for an effective test is fruitless
- ❖ Individuals, families and professionals reluctant to talk about dementia and driving
- ❖ Driving retirement causes distress, depression and lowered self esteem
- ❖ Crises occur and individuals are forced to retire from driving

Stage 6: USA version of the DDDA booklet



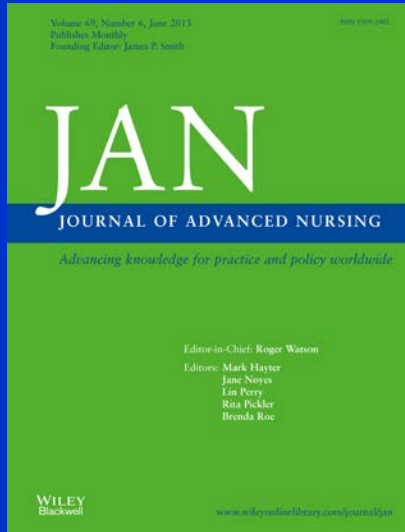



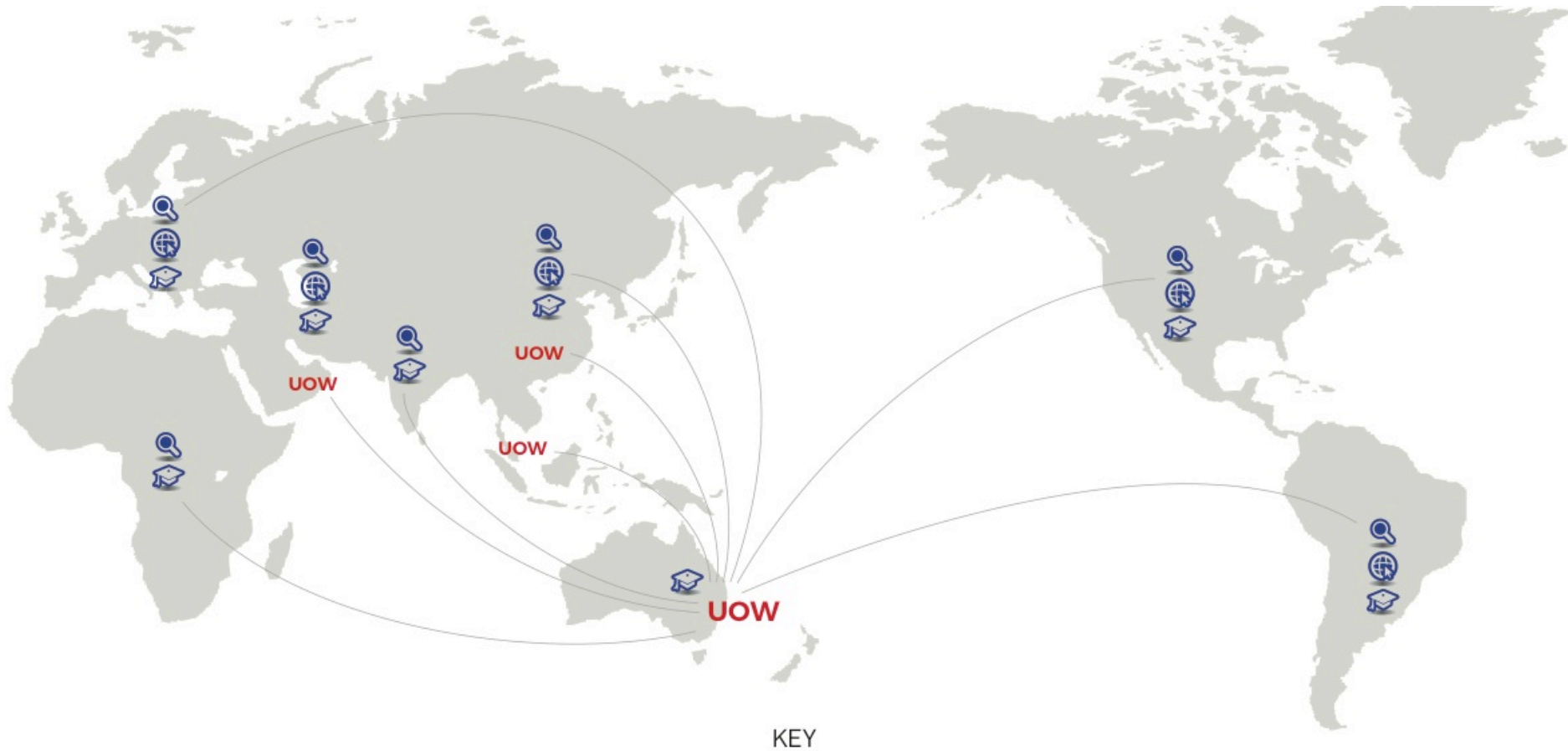
